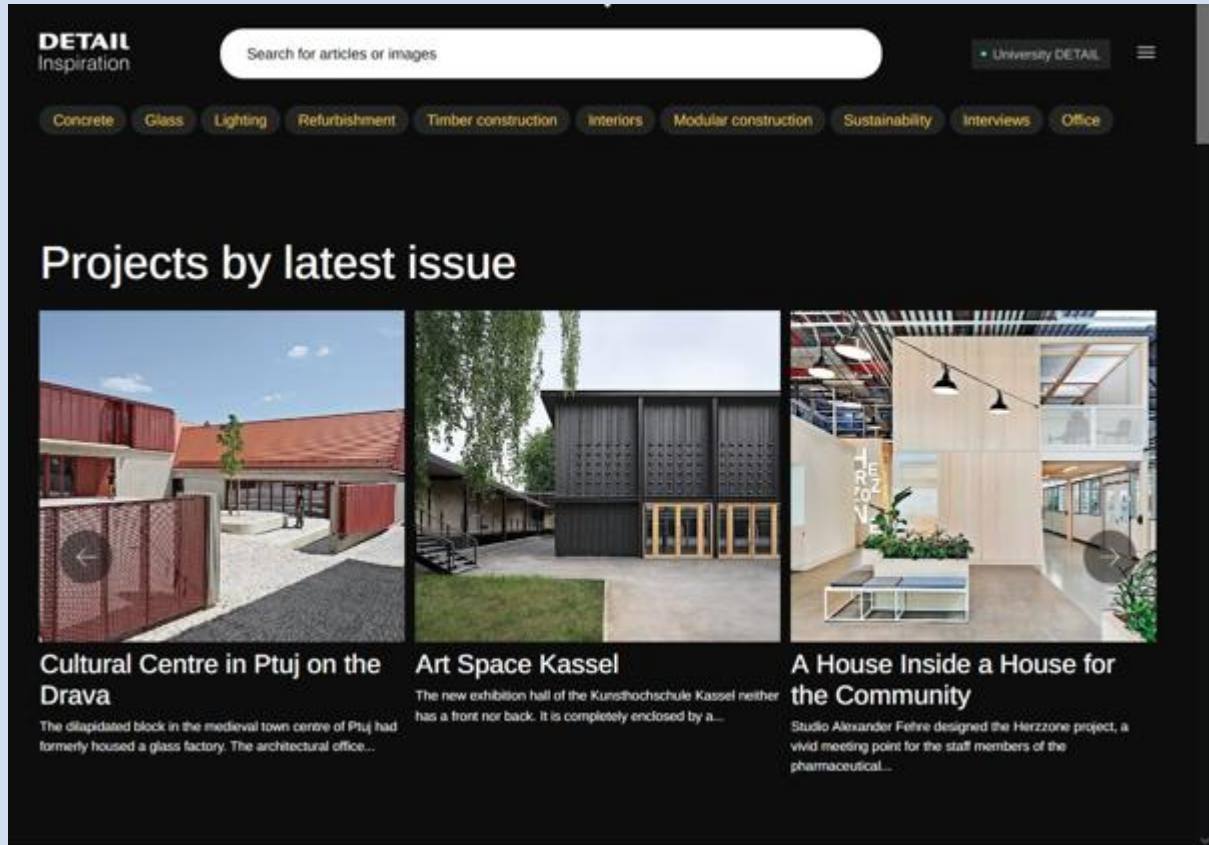

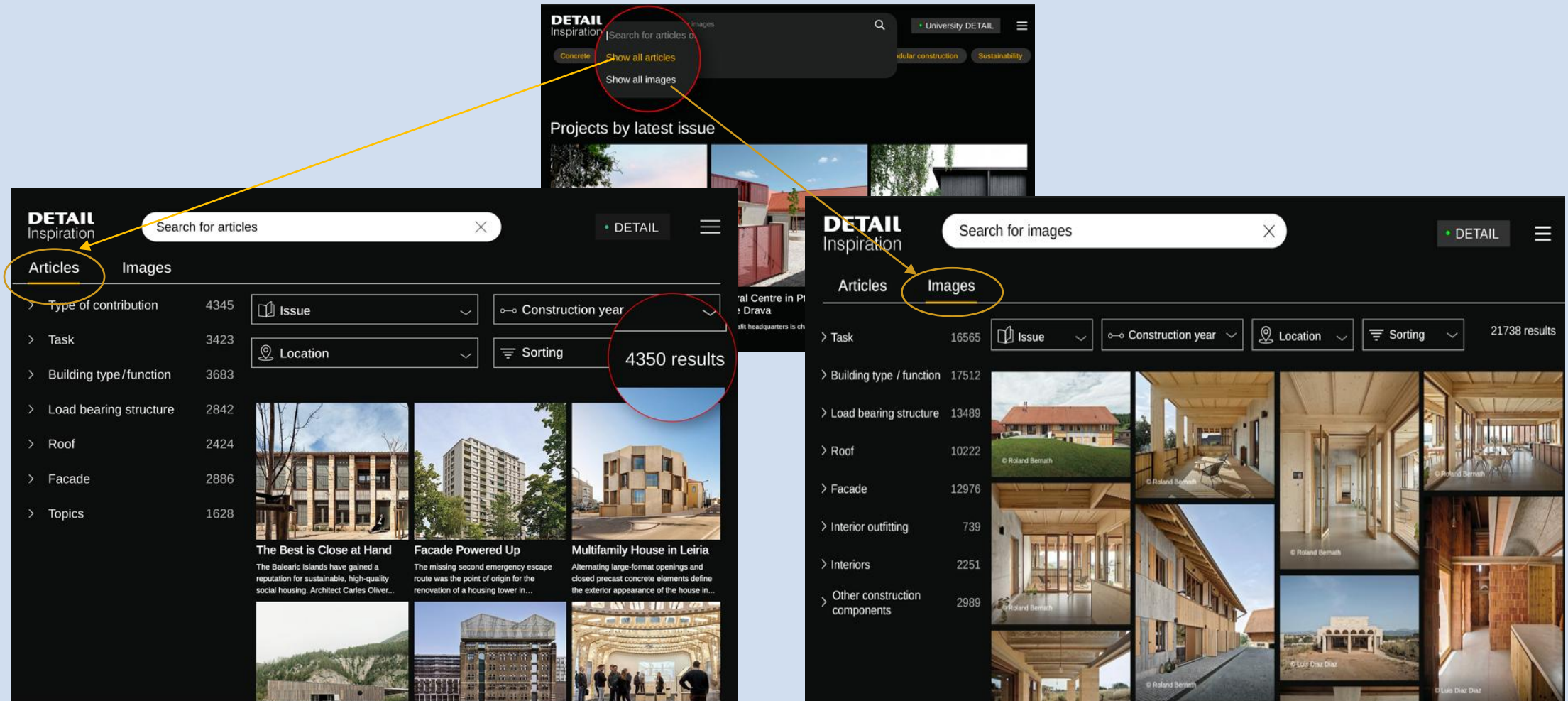

1. How can I find suitable projects for my research?

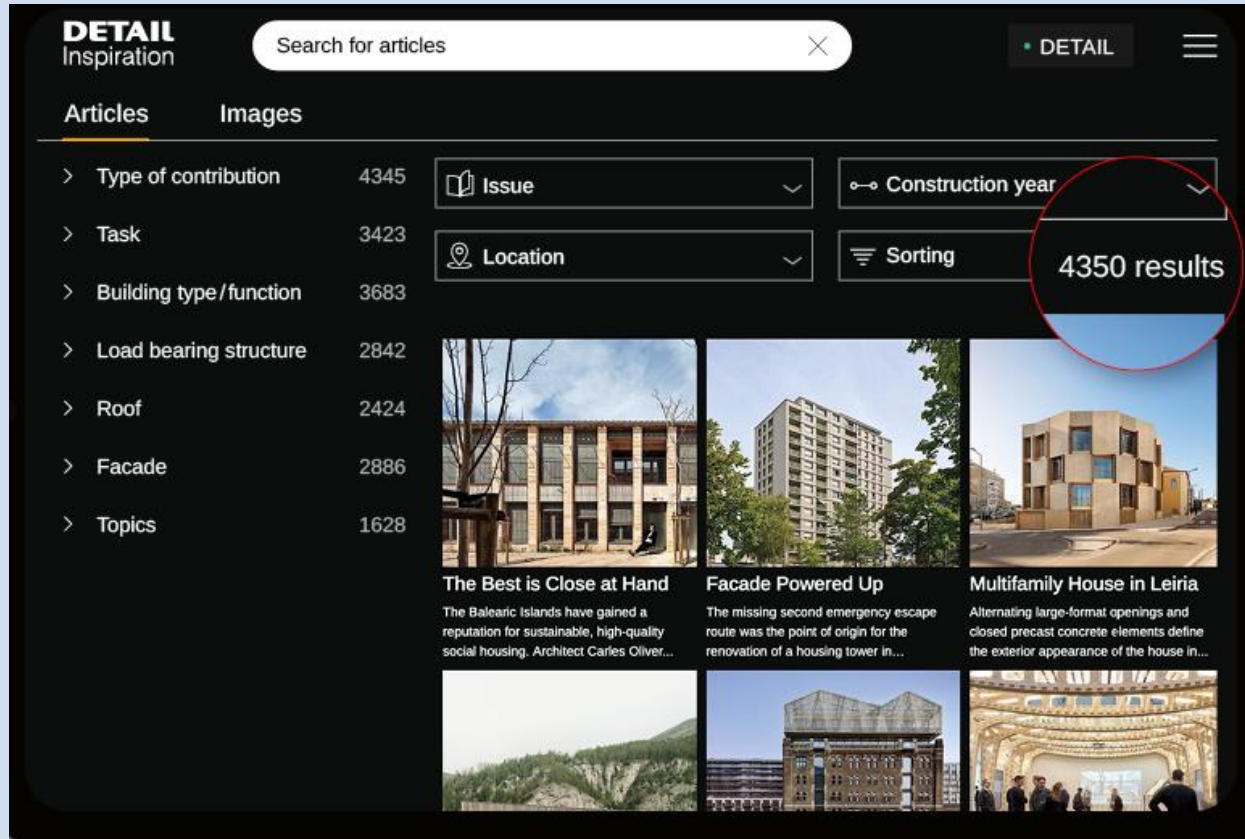
One option is to use the **keyword search**.

Place your cursor at the **search bar** to activate redesigned hierarchical filter. This allows you to search not only for **articles** but also for **images**.



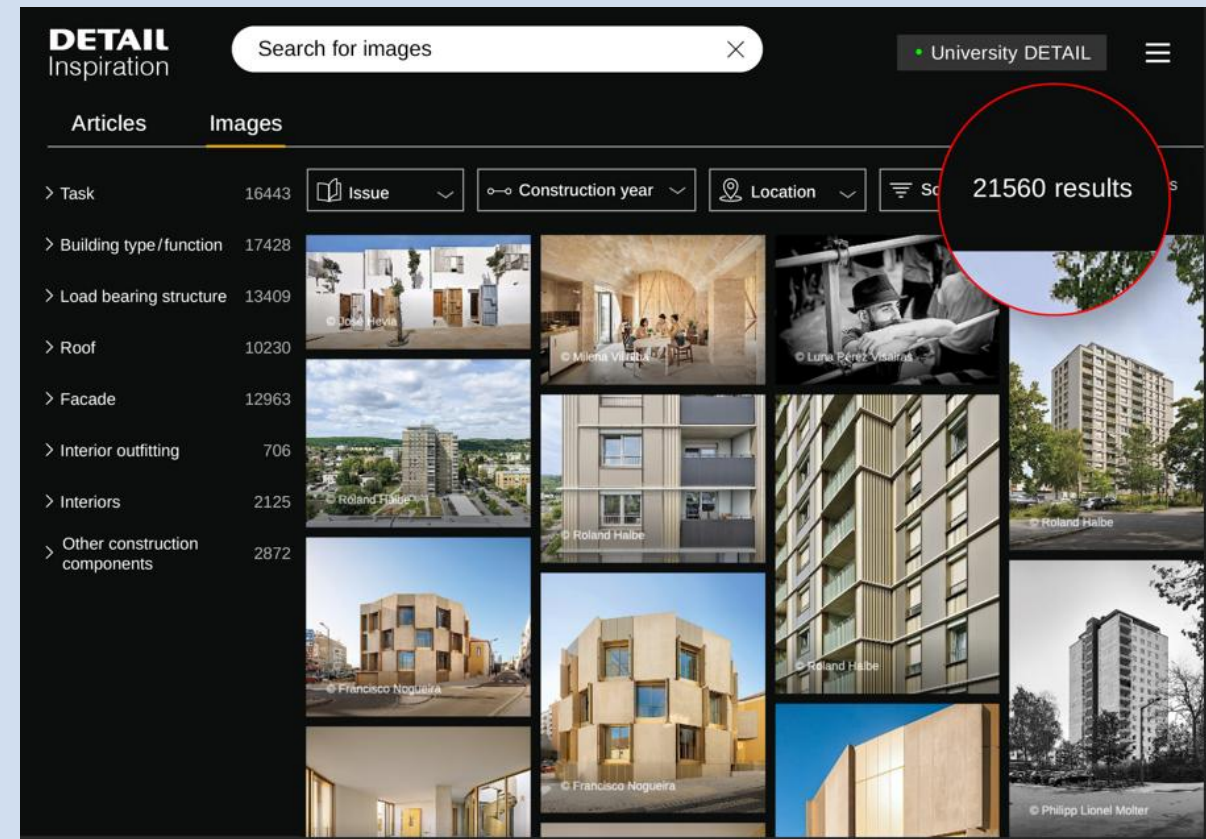

You have access to more than 4,000 articles. DETAIL Inspiration includes more than 4,000 projects and it is expanded monthly with new projects. The majority of the construction drawings are available at a scale of 1:20.

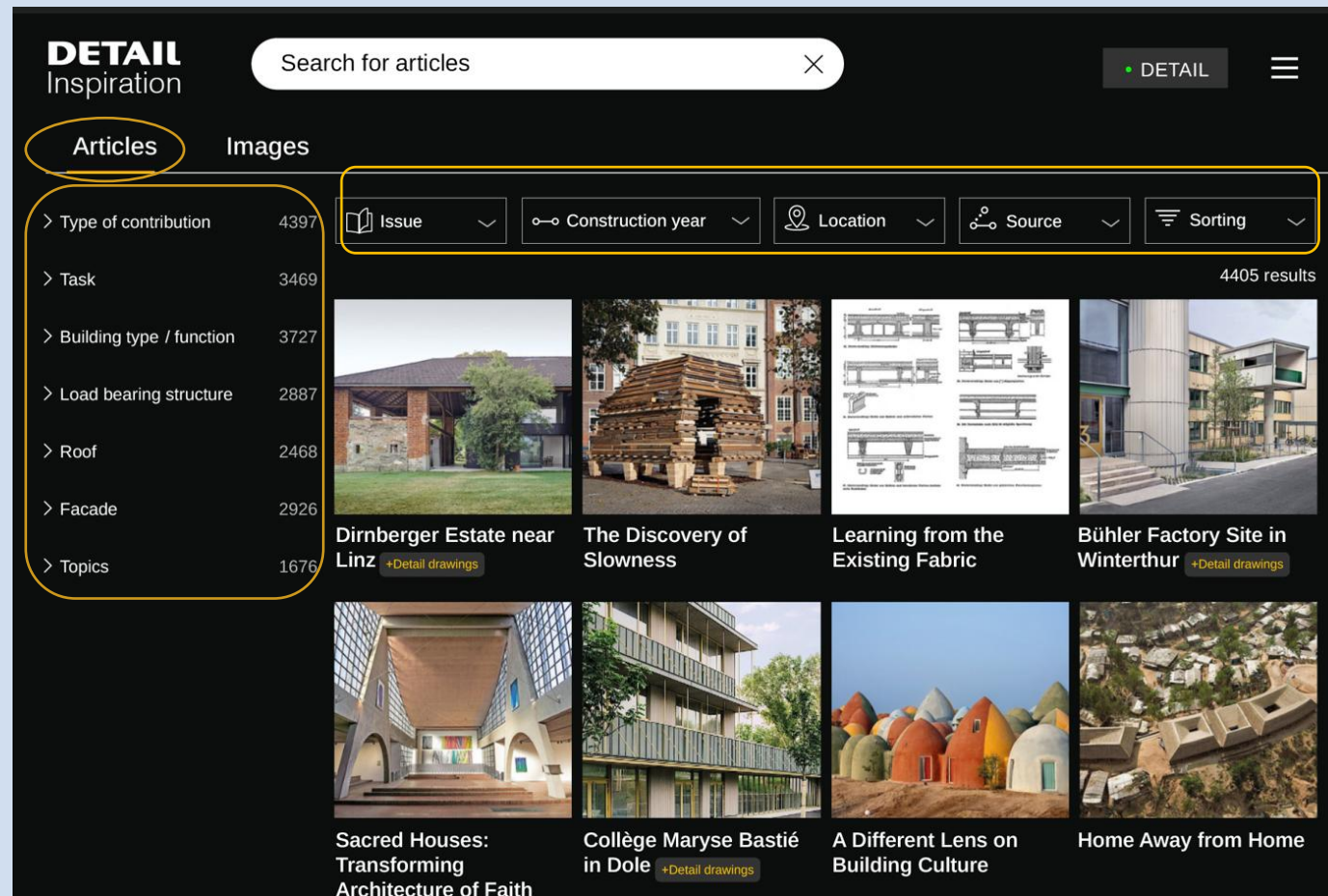


You have access to more than 21,000 images. Each image is linked directly to the corresponding project so that you can find relevant information.

Alternating large-format openings and closed precast concrete elements define the exterior appearance of the house in the small Portuguese town of Leiria. Prominently located at a traffic intersection on the rim of the historic centre, the building presents its curved main facade to the surrounding streetscape.

The multifamily structure consists of two parts: a two-storey volume erected in the early 20th century and a four-storey addition with a fan-shaped floor plan connected to the corner of the old edifice. The latter is a typical example of local architecture. Its envelope – a facade with yellow render and arched window openings, covered by a red tile roof – was maintained and carefully renovated.

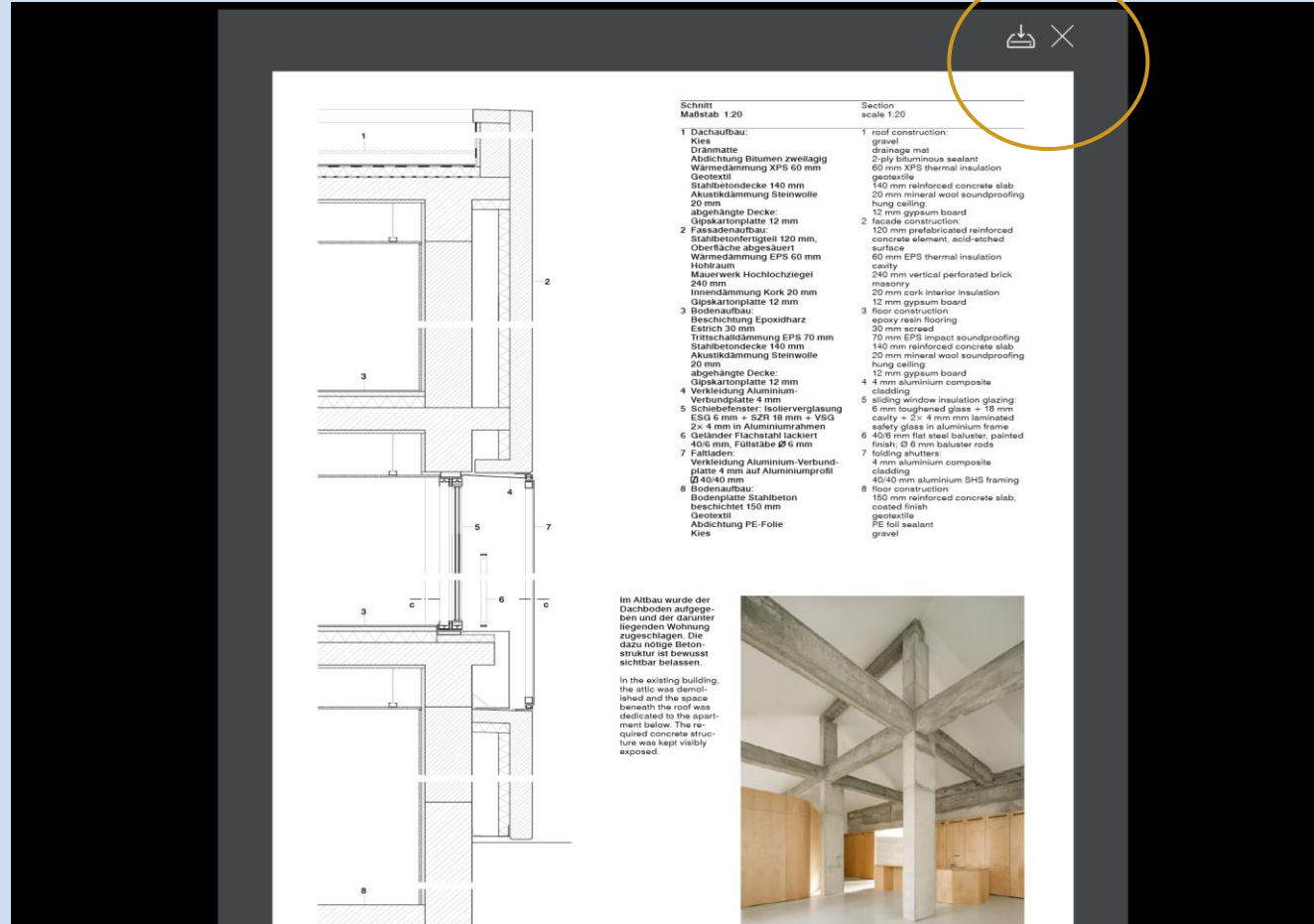
